7 Grande City High School in 2007; and

9 the Laredo College Regional Law Enforcement Academy in 2010; he  
10 went on to earn an associate's degree in criminal justice from South  
11 Texas College in 2015 and a bachelor's degree in criminal justice  
12 from Lamar University in 2017, and he distinguished himself in his  
13 work as an investigator for the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office;

15           WHEREAS, At the time of his death, Mr. Molina was employed by  
16 Sharyland High School in Mission as a criminal justice teacher;

18 an adviser for the school's criminal justice club, and he created a

20 inspiring some to continue their studies in criminal justice; a  
21 kind and caring man, he was beloved for his optimism and strength of  
22 character, and he made a lasting difference in his community; and

24 soon, Reynaldo Molina will forever be remembered with great
