1-27 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-28 AN ACT

1-29 relating to an appropriation for border security.
 1-30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-31 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION TO TRUSTEED PROGRAMS WITHIN THE
 1-32 OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR. (a) The amount of \$1,540,000,000 is
 1-33 appropriated from the general revenue fund to the Trusteed Programs
 1-34 within the Office of the Governor for use during the two-year period
 1-35 beginning on the effective date of this Act for the purpose of
 1-36 providing funding for border security operations and the
 1-37 construction, operation, and maintenance of border barrier
 1-38 infrastructure.
 1-39 (b) Of the amount appropriated by Subsection (a) of this
 1-40 section, the Trusteed Programs within the Office of the Governor
 1-41 shall transfer \$40,000,000 to the Department of Public Safety for
 1-42 border security operations, including paying for additional
 1-43 overtime expenses and costs due to an increased law enforcement
 1-44 presence to preserve public safety and security in the Colony Ridge
 1-45 development in Liberty County, Texas.
 1-46 SECTION 2. PROHIBITIONS ON USE OF APPROPRIATED MONEY. The
 1-47 money appropriated by this Act may not be used to:
 1-48 (1) acquire property through the exercise of eminent
 1-49 domain;
 1-50 (2) build a barrier along this state's international
 1-51 border with Mexico on property acquired through the exercise of
 1-52 eminent domain;
 1-53 (3) acquire property for a barrier that abuts the
 1-54 boundary between this state and another state; or
 1-55 (4) build a barrier that abuts the boundary between
 1-56 this state and another state.
 1-57 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
 1-58 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
 1-59 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
 1-60 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for

2-1 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
2-2 last day of the legislative session.

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
