Section 46.01(3), Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (3) 7 "Firearm" means any device designed, made, or adapted to expel a projectile through a barrel by using the energy 8 9 generated by an explosion or burning substance or any device readily convertible to that use. Firearm does not include: 10 11 (A) a firearm that may have, as an integral part, a folding knife blade or other characteristics of weapons made 12 illegal by this chapter and that is: 13 14 (i) [<del>(A)</del>] an antique or curio firearm manufactured before 1899; or 15 16 (ii) [<del>(B)</del>] a replica of an antique or curio firearm manufactured before 1899, but only if the replica does not 17 use rim fire or center fire ammunition; or 18 (B) a less-lethal projectile device. 19 SECTION 2. Section 46.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding 20 21 Subdivision (21) to read as follows: (21) "Less-lethal projectile device" means any 22 23 weapon, device, or munition that is designed, made, or adapted to expel a projectile that inflicts an electrical charge against a 24

## 1 <u>target to temporarily incapacitate the target while minimizing the</u> 2 <u>risk of serious bodily injury or death.</u>

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 5 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 7 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 8 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 9 before that date. 10

11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 12 last day of the legislative session.
