S.B. No. 80

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the salary and wages paid to public school employees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
5 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and
6 (d) to read as follows:

7 (c) The salary factors per step are as follows:

28 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2024-2025
29 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time

1 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school
2 nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the
3 sum of:

4 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
5 received for the 2024-2025 school year under the district's salary
6 schedule for the 2023-2024 school year, if that schedule had been in
7 effect for the 2024-2025 school year, including any local
8 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
9 the employee would have received in the 2024-2025 school year; and

10 (2) \$1,500.

11 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September
12 1, 2025.

13 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
14 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school
15 nurse employed by a school district in the 2024-2025 school year is,
16 as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled
17 to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee
18 received for the 2024-2025 school year.

19 SECTION 2. Section [22.107](#), Education Code, is amended by
20 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

21 (b-1) For the 2024-2025 school year, a school district shall
22 increase the wages of each full-time employee, other than an
23 administrator or an employee subject to the minimum salary schedule
24 under Section [21.402](#), by 25 percent over the wages received by that
25 employee in the 2023-2024 school year. A district employee to which
26 this subsection applies is entitled to wages in school years
27 subsequent to the 2024-2025 school year in an amount that is at

1 least equal to the amount paid by the district to that employee in
2 the 2024-2025 school year if the employee has remained employed in
3 the same position.

4 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 48, Education Code, is
5 amended by adding Section 48.2521 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 48.2521. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR COMPENSATION
7 INCREASES FOR NONADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES. (a) A school district,
8 including a school district that is otherwise ineligible for state
9 aid under this chapter, is entitled to annual state aid in the sum
10 of:

11 (1) the amount equal to the product of \$15,000
12 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers, full-time
13 librarians, full-time school counselors certified under Subchapter
14 B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by the
15 district; and

16 (2) the amount the district is required to pay for wage
17 increases under Section 22.107(b-1).

18 (b) A school district shall use the amount received under
19 this section for purposes of:

20 (1) salary increases under Section 21.402; and

21 (2) wage increases under Section 22.107(b-1).

22 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is
23 repealed.

24 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2024-2025
25 school year.

26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
4 legislative session.
