- 7 INCREASES FOR NONADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES. (a) A school district,
- 8 including a school district that is otherwise ineligible for state
- 9 aid under this chapter, is entitled to annual state aid in the sum
- 10 <u>of:</u>
- 11 (1) the amount equal to the product of \$15,000
- 12 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers, full-time

- 14 B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by the

- 16 (2) the amount the district is required to pay for wage

- 18 (b) A school district shall use the amount received under

- SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2024-2025
