WHEREAS, On May 16, 1973, Mr. Jones married Margie Bryan in a ceremony held in Pineland; they raised two sons, Shane and Chad, and through the years, they were further blessed with four grandchildren, Matthew, Carson, Connor, and Ashlyn, who were his pride and joy; devoted to his family, Mr. Jones was especially close to his sister, Charlene, and her husband, Nat, whom he called his "second dad"; he was sustained by a strong faith from an early age; and
