	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to border protection agreements between this state and the
3	United Mexican States.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	ARTICLE 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDING
6	SECTION 1.01. (a) The legislature, acting with the
7	governor, has the solemn duty to protect and defend the citizens of
8	this state and maintain sovereignty over this state's borders.
9	(b) An individual entering this state from a foreign country
10	shall enter through a legal port of entry.
11	ARTICLE 2. BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS
12	SECTION 2.01. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by
13	adding Chapter 795 to read as follows:
14	CHAPTER 795. BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS WITH UNITED MEXICAN
15	STATES
16	Sec. 795.001. AUTHORITY FOR AGREEMENTS AND ENGAGEMENT WITH
17	AUTHORITIES OF UNITED MEXICAN STATES. (a) On behalf of this state,
18	the governor may coordinate, develop, and execute agreements with
19	the United Mexican States and the states of the United Mexican
20	States regarding the authority of this state to protect and defend
21	its citizens.
22	(b) The governor may appoint a group of individuals
23	responsible for meeting in person with the appropriate local,
24	state, and federal authorities of the United Mexican States to

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1	coordinate, develop, and execute agreements under Subsection (a).
2	The group appointed under this subsection may operate within the
3	United Mexican States as practicable.
4	ARTICLE 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
5	SECTION 3.01. This Act takes effect immediately if it
6	receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
7	house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
8	If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
9	effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of
10	the legislative session.
