A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to requirements for legislation increasing expenditures
- 3 by public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 1.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1.007. REQUIREMENTS FOR LEGISLATION INCREASING
- 8 EXPENDITURES BY PUBLIC SCHOOLS. (a) In this section, "state
- 9 <u>educational mandate" means a statutory provision or agency rule the</u>
- 10 implementation of which requires an expenditure by a school
- 11 district or open-enrollment charter school that would not have been
- 12 required in the absence of the statutory provision or the rule
- 13 adopted under that provision.
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, legislation that imposes
- 15 a state educational mandate on a school district or open-enrollment
- 16 charter school and that does not provide for the payment or
- 17 reimbursement of the required expenditure must also:
- 18 (1) increase the basic allotment under Section 48.051
- 19 in an amount sufficient to cover the cost of the increased
- 20 <u>expenditures required by the legislation; or</u>
- 21 (2) eliminate one or more existing state educational
- 22 mandates for which the amount of expenditures required by a
- 23 district or school under those mandates is at least equal to the
- 24 amount of expenditures required by the legislation.

- 1 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, a school district or
- 2 open-enrollment charter school is not required to comply with
- 3 legislation that fails to comply with Subsection (b).
- 4 (d) For each proposed piece of legislation related to
- 5 primary and secondary education, the agency shall:
- 6 (1) determine whether this section applies to the
- 7 <u>legislation; and</u>
- 8 (2) provide written notice to the Legislative Budget
- 9 Board of the agency's determination under Subdivision (1) for the
- 10 board to include in the impact statement prepared under Section
- 11 314.004, Government Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 314.004, Government Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 14 (d) The impact statement must include the Texas Education
- 15 Agency's state educational mandate determination provided to the
- 16 board under Section 1.007, Education Code.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 18 last day of the legislative session.
