- 2 relating to a cost-of-living adjustment applicable to certain

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 814, Government Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 814.605 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 814.605. ONE-TIME ADJUSTMENT TO BENEFITS. (a) The
- 10 <u>amount of a monthly service retirement benefit, disability</u>
- 11 retirement benefit, or death benefit paid under this chapter to a
- 12 retiree or beneficiary for service credited in the employee class
- 13 <u>is increased to include a one-time 10 percent adjustment in</u>
- 14 accordance with this section.
- 15 (b) The board of trustees shall recompute the amount of a
- 16 benefit paid monthly under this chapter by applying the 10 percent
- 17 adjustment to the monthly amount otherwise required to be paid as
- 18 determined in accordance with this chapter.
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 815, Government Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 815.5105 to read as follows:
- Sec. 815.5105. BIENNIAL STUDY AND REPORT ON PROVIDING
- 22 ADDITIONAL COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS BASED ON EFFECTS OF
- 23 INFLATION. Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the
- 24 retirement system shall:

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- (1) conduct a study to evaluate and identify the 1 effects, if any, that increased inflation has had on annuitants of 2 3 the system: 4 (A) during the preceding state fiscal biennium; 5 and 6 (B) if applicable, since annuitants last 7 received a cost-of-living adjustment; and 8 (2) submit a written report to the legislature containing: 9 10 (A) findings of the study; and (B) if appropriate, recommendations 11 12 potential legislation to address any adverse effects of inflation identified under Subdivision (1), including specific 13
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 814.604, Government Code, is repealed.

18 SECTION 4. Section 814.605, Government Code, as added by 19 this Act, applies only to a monthly benefit payment made by the
