5	SECTION 1. Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by this section, a school district
8	may not begin instruction for students for a school year before [the
9	fourth Monday in August $\underline{1}$. A school district may [÷

11	before [$\frac{1}{2}$ the fourth Monday in] August $\frac{1}{2}$ if the district operates a
12	year-round system under Section 25.084[; or
13	[(2) begin instruction for students for a school year
14	on or after the first Monday in August at a campus or at not more
15	than 20 percent of the campuses in the district if:
16	[(A) the district has a student enrollment of
17	190,000 or more;
18	[(B) the district at the beginning of the school
19	year provides, financed with local funds, days of instruction for
20	students at the campus or at each of the multiple campuses, in
21	addition to the minimum number of days of instruction required
22	under Section 25.081;
23	(C) the campus or each of the multiple campuses
24	are undergoing comprehensive reform, as determined by the board of

- 1 trustees of the district; and
- 2 [(D) a majority of the students at the campus or
- 3 at each of the multiple campuses are educationally disadvantaged].
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2024-2025
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 7 last day of the legislative session.
