## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to social security coverage for employees of public
- 3 school districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) Not later than July 1, 2024, each public
- 6 school district in this state not currently participating in an
- 7 agreement under Subchapter B, Chapter 606, Government Code, to
- 8 provide social security coverage to all of the employees of the
- 9 district, shall conduct a referendum by secret ballot of the
- 10 employees of the district, as required by Section 218, Social
- 11 Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 418), to determine whether a
- 12 majority of the employees are in favor of being included in the
- 13 agreement of this state with the commissioner of the Social
- 14 Security Administration or the individual designated by the
- 15 commissioner to administer coverage of the Social Security Act to
- 16 employees of a state and its political subdivisions.
- 17 (b) If a majority of the employees of a school district vote
- 18 in favor of entering into the agreement to provide social security
- 19 coverage, the board of trustees of the school district shall as soon
- 20 as practicable submit the necessary plan to the state social
- 21 security administrator to effect the participation of the school
- 22 district under Subchapter B, Chapter 606, Government Code.
- SECTION 2. This Act expires July 1, 2027.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 5 legislative session.
