6 a full-time direct care staff member for the Caldwell, Comal, and
7 Hays CSCD; among her responsibilities, she has facilitated day
8 treatment programs for Caldwell, Comal, and Hays Counties in her
9 capacity as a treatment counselor while also overseeing intensive
10 outpatient treatment; she first embarked on her career with the
11 agency in August 2002 as a part-time group facilitator in the Adult
12 Probation Department, where she directed offender education
13 groups, cognitive behavioral groups, and support groups; and

15 Ms. Vega-Alvarado provides support to individuals in criminal
16 justice settings and aftercare services to those who have completed
17 the initial stages of substance abuse treatment; she treats all of

19 of care to her colleagues as well; during the COVID-19 pandemic, she
20 distinguished herself by offering virtual services and conducting
21 weekly check-ins by phone to offer encouragement to her clients;

24 compassion, Isabel Vega-Alvarado has made a positive difference in

1 the lives of countless individuals, and she has earned the lasting
2 admiration and appreciation of all those who have worked with her;
