1 WHEREAS, Country singer, songwriter, and producer Kyle Park
2 has delighted audiences and listeners for more than two decades;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Austin and raised in Leander, Kyle Park
5 started playing guitar at the age of 14; after graduating from high
6 school, he attended Texas State University before leaving school to
7 focus on music; he continued to play in local clubs and assembled a
8 band, and in 2005, released his first album, *Big Time*; three years
9 later, he founded his own music label, Kyle Park Music, which
10 released his second album, *Anywhere in Texas*; and

11 WHEREAS, Blending fiddle, pedal steel, and searing guitar
12 riffs with contemplative lyrics, Mr. Park has gained a reputation
13 for his live performances; he plays more than 100 shows annually and
14 has opened for such legendary artists as George Strait, Clint
15 Black, and Mark Chesnutt; through the years, he has had 7 No. 1
16 singles on the Texas Regional Radio Report and 11 singles on the
17 Texas Music Chart's Top 10; his pair of EPs from 2010 were remixed
18 and combined with additional tracks for the 2011 full-length album,
19 *Make or Break Me*, which appeared on the Country Albums chart;
20 moreover, the first song from his fourth album, *Beggin' for More*,
21 was a hit in Texas, and in 2015, he signed a distribution deal with
22 Thirty Tigers, which released his fifth album, *The Blue Roof*
23 *Sessions*; he followed that up with his sixth record, *Don't Forget*
24 *Where You Come From*, in 2018; and

1 WHEREAS, Throughout his career, Kyle Park has distinguished
2 himself with his outstanding talent and dedication to his craft,
3 and he is indeed deserving of recognition for adding to the rich
4 musical heritage of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
6 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby honor Kyle Park for his
7 contributions to Texas music and extend to him sincere best wishes
8 for continued success; and, be it further

9 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
10 prepared for Mr. Park as an expression of high regard by the Texas
11 House of Representatives.
