21 award from the North Harris County branch of the American  
22 Association of University Women; and

24 degree in education from Oklahoma State University, and she earned

1 a master trustee certification from Leadership TASB; in all her  
2 endeavors, she enjoys the love and support of a fine family that  
3 includes her husband, Tom, and their two children; and

4 WHEREAS, Georgan Reitmeier's hard work, professionalism, and  
5 commitment to excellence have greatly benefited the students of  
6 Klein ISD and earned the respect and admiration of her peers, and  
7 her contributions will resonate in the community for years to come;
