1 WHEREAS, Shen Yun Performing Arts is launching its 2024 world
2 tour at Jones Hall in Houston from December 26, 2023, to January 1,
3 2024; and

4 WHEREAS, This year marks the 18th anniversary of Shen Yun's
5 establishment in the United States; in 2006, a small group of elite
6 Chinese artists came together in New York with the mission to revive
7 traditional Chinese culture and share it with the world; since
8 then, Shen Yun has staged magnificent live performances of
9 classical Chinese dance that incorporate a blend of Eastern
10 instrumentation and Western symphony orchestra to portray 5,000
11 years of Chinese history and culture; and

12 WHEREAS, Each year, Shen Yun Performing Arts designs
13 brand-new productions that take audiences back through time and
14 space to experience China before the advent of Communism; since its
15 inception, Shen Yun has grown to eight equally sized companies that
16 tour around the world synchronously; it will kick off its 2024
17 season in Houston on December 26, 2023, which will be followed by
18 performances in Dallas, Austin, Lubbock, San Antonio, McAllen,
19 Midland, and El Paso, for a total of 37 shows in Texas; and

20 WHEREAS, Shen Yun has introduced countless patrons to the
21 exquisite beauty and richness of traditional Chinese culture and
22 dance, and it is a pleasure to join in celebrating the return of
23 Shen Yun and its impressively talented performers to the Bayou
24 City; now, therefore, be it
