R E S O L U T I O N

2 passing of Judith Morrow Boyd Hirschfeld of San Angelo on
3 October 7, 2023, at the age of 83; and

4 WHEREAS, The daughter of Lillian and Preston Morrow, the
5 former Judith Morrow was born on February 9, 1940, in Rotan, and she
6 grew up with the companionship of a brother, Preston; she graduated
7 from Texas Tech University; during her marriage to her first
8 husband, the late William Boyd, she proudly supported his career in
9 the U.S. Air Force and served as a schoolteacher wherever they were
10 stationed; she later became the volunteer coordinator for Hospice
11 of San Angelo; and

12 WHEREAS, In 1992, Mrs. Hirschfeld married David Hirschfeld,
13 and the couple enjoyed a rewarding union that spanned more than
14 three decades; together, they contributed to many charitable
15 organizations, and she became especially passionate about animals;
16 over the years, she was active in Weimaraner rescue efforts and
17 adopted numerous dogs; in 2020, she and her husband opened the
18 Judith and David Hirschfeld Adoption Center for Concho Valley PAWS;
19 she was also involved in local and national Republican politics;
20 moreover, she was a valued congregant of the First Methodist Church
21 in San Angelo, where she volunteered with the children and youth
22 ministries; and

23 WHEREAS, Above all else, Mrs. Hirschfeld took great pride in
24 her cherished family, which grew to include her son, Ted, and

1 grandsons, Harrison and Hayden, as well as Mr. Hirschfeld's
2 children, David, Shawnee, Kendall, and Wendall, and his
3 grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and

4 WHEREAS, Judith Hirschfeld lived a rich and purposeful life
5 dedicated to her loved ones, her faith, and her community, and she
6 earned the lasting respect and admiration of all who were
7 privileged to know her; now, therefore, be it

9 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
