- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 29.153(b), Education Code, is amended to 5
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten
- class under this section if the child is at least three years of age 8
- and: 9

- 10 (1)is unable to speak and comprehend the English
- 11 language;
- 12 (2) is educationally disadvantaged;
- is homeless, regardless of the residence of the 13 (3)
- child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or 14
- 15 other person having lawful control of the child;
- is the child of an active duty member of the armed 16
- forces of the United States, including the state military forces or 17
- a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active 18
- duty by proper authority; 19
- is the child of a member of the armed forces of the 20
- 21 United States, including the state military forces or a reserve
- 22 component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while
- serving on active duty; 23
- 24 (6) is or ever has been in:

- 1 (A) the conservatorship of the Department of
- 2 Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing held
- 3 as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or
- 4 (B) foster care in another state or territory, if
- 5 the child resides in this state; [or]
- 6 (7) is the child of a person eligible for the Star of
- 7 Texas Award as:
- 8 (A) a peace officer under Section 3106.002,
- 9 Government Code;
- 10 (B) a firefighter under Section 3106.003,
- 11 Government Code; or
- 12 (C) an emergency medical first responder under
- 13 Section 3106.004, Government Code; or
- 14 (8) is the child of a person employed as a classroom
- 15 teacher at a public primary or secondary school in this state.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2024-2025
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 23 legislative session.
