S.B. No. 29

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use, possession, delivery, or manufacture of  
3 testing equipment that identifies the presence of a substance  
4 listed in Penalty Group 1-B.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 481.125, Health and Safety Code, is  
7 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:

8 (j) This section does not apply to a person who uses,  
9 possesses with intent to use, delivers, possesses with intent to  
10 deliver, or manufactures with intent to deliver testing equipment  
11 that identifies the presence of a substance listed in Penalty Group  
12 1-B.

13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.  
15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is  
16 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed,  
17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For  
18 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the  
19 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred  
20 before that date.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the  
22 last day of the legislative session.
