

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 12

WHEREAS, The Burnet High School FFA team achieved great distinction by winning the national championship in the meats evaluation and technology category at the 2023 National FFA Convention and Expo; and

WHEREAS, Advancing to the national meet after excelling at the local and state levels, the Burnet High contingent claimed top honors in the meats evaluation and technology career development event; the competition included a general knowledge exam, a beef carcass evaluation, the identification of wholesale and retail cuts of beef, lamb, and pork, the quality and yield grading of beef carcasses, a team meat merchandising event, and the solving of a meat formulation problem; and
