- 20 temple in Tyler, and he served as district deputy Grand Master of
- 21 the Grand Lodge of Texas District 10 for two years; and
- WHEREAS, A man of faith, Dr. Cline was a devoted member of
- 23 Emmanuel Baptist Church, where he attended Sunday school; during
- 24 his retirement years, he enjoyed working on his farm and spending
