5 Angelo State University before enjoying a successful 25-year career
6 with Delta Air Lines; she also honed her skills in event management
7 through her work in the Park City, Utah, area; and

9 coordinator for the San Angelo Chamber of Commerce led to her being
10 promoted to vice president of member relations for the
11 organization; she was subsequently hired as the district director
12 for State Senator Charles Perry, and she performed her duties in
13 that role with skill and dedication for nearly six years; and

14 WHEREAS, Deeply committed to her community, Ms. Lewis served
15 on the advisory council of the San Angelo Clubhouse, an
16 organization devoted to supporting and empowering adults with
17 mental illness; she further distinguished herself through her
18 contributions to the United Way and the San Angelo Pachyderm Club,
19 which she previously led as president; and

20 WHEREAS, Laura Lewis demonstrated a passion for life and a
21 steadfast commitment to the causes in which she believed, and
22 although she will be greatly missed, her legacy will continue to
23 inspire all those who were privileged to know her; now, therefore,
