**SB 2598, as Filed by Representative Angela Paxton  
Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Comments**

The Legislative Budget Board, in cooperation with the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), has determined that:

Senate Bill (SB) 2598, as authored by Senator Angela Paxton adds Chapter 3796 Special District Local Laws Code to create the Honey Creek Improvement District No. 1 (District) with the powers and duties of Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III and Section 59, Article XVI of the Texas Constitution, Chapters 375 of the Local Government Code granted to municipal management districts, and Chapters 49 and 54 of the Water Code granted to special districts.

**Comments on Powers/Duties Different from Similar Types of Districts** – The bill grants the District authority to issue, by public or private sale, bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from assessments, revenue, contract payments, grants, or other District money, or any combination of those sources of money, to pay for any authorized District purpose. Municipalities must consent, by ordinance or resolution, to the creation of the District before issuance of bonds. The District is created to promote, develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce, transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts, entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public welfare in the District. The District is created to supplement and not to supplant the City of McKinney (City) services provided in the District.

The District may create a tax increment reinvestment zone under Chapter 311, Tax Code or a tax abatement reinvestment zone under Chapter 312, Tax Code. The District has authority to provide for water, wastewater, drainage, road, recreational facilities, and pedestrian ways. The District must have a development agreement between the City and the primary landowner in the District before exercising District power. The board shall dissolve the District if the development agreement is not executed before September 1, 2024.

Directors are elected as provided by Subchapter D, Chapter 49, Water Code and serve staggered four-year terms. The bill names five temporary directors: 1. Rafael Parker, 2. Mateo Jaramillo, 3. Hector Alba, 4. Laura Santos, and 5. Ricardo Soto. Terms for temporary directors one through three expire June 1, 2025, and directors four and five expire June 1, 2027.

The implementation of a District project or service is a governmental function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791, Government Code. The

District may add or exclude land in the manner provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code, or by Subchapter H, Chapter 54, Water Code, only if the City governing body consents to the addition by ordinance or resolution. The District may be divided by a board motion or by petition of the majority of real property landowners if there is no outstanding bonded debt or if the District is not imposing ad valorem taxes. Municipal consent to the creation of the District and to the inclusion of land in the District acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new district created by the division of the District and to the inclusion of land in the new district.

The board may not finance a service or improvement project with assessments unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement has been filed with the board. The board may impose and collect an assessment by resolution. The District may be dissolved by two-thirds of the taxable property owners or by two-thirds of the surface area of property owners.

Sections 375.161 and 375.262 of the Local Government Code, do not apply to the District. The District may not impose an ad valorem tax and has no eminent domain authority.

**Overlapping Services:** TCEQ does not have mapping information for water and/or wastewater providers because this function was transferred from the TCEQ to the Public Utility Commission on September 1, 2014. As a result, TCEQ is unaware of possible overlapping service providers.

**TCEQ's Supervision:** As with general law districts, the TCEQ will have general supervisory authority, including bond review authority and review of financial reports.

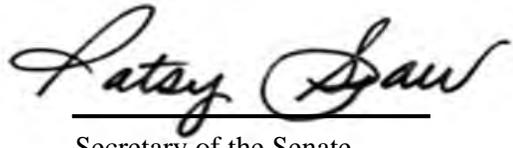

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Honey Creek Improvement District No. 1; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments and fees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3796 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 3796. HONEY CREEK IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 3796.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district 's board of directors.

(2) "City" means the City of McKinney.

(3) "Director" means a board member.

(4) "District" means the Honey Creek Improvement

District No. 1.

Sec. 3796.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The Honey Creek Improvement District No. 1 is a special district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 3796.0103. PURPOSE; DECLARATION OF INTENT. (a) The creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this chapter.

(b) By creating the district and in authorizing the city and

1 other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the  
2 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public  
3 purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution.

4 (c) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,  
5 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,  
6 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,  
7 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public  
8 welfare in the district.

9 (d) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be  
10 interpreted to relieve the city from providing the level of  
11 services provided as of the effective date of the Act enacting this  
12 chapter to the area in the district. The district is created to  
13 supplement and not to supplant city services provided in the  
14 district.

15 Sec. 3796.0104. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE.

16 (a) All land and other property included in the district will  
17 benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the  
18 district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a, Article  
19 III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and other  
20 powers granted under this chapter.

21 (b) The district is created to serve a public use and  
22 benefit.

23 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest  
24 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

25 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the  
26 state;

27 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and

1           (3) developing or expanding transportation and  
2 commerce.

3           (d) The district will:

4           (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of  
5 residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,  
6 and consumers in the district, and of the public;

7           (2) provide needed funding for the district to  
8 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of  
9 the district territory as a community and business center;

10           (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment  
11 of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and  
12 developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for  
13 the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty;  
14 and

15           (4) provide for water, wastewater, drainage, road, and  
16 recreational facilities for the district.

17           (e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at  
18 grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street  
19 landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and  
20 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street  
21 or road improvement.

22           (f) The district will not act as the agent or  
23 instrumentality of any private interest even though the district  
24 will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

25           Sec. 3796.0105. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The  
26 district is initially composed of the territory described by  
27 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

1       (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of  
2 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the  
3 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process  
4 does not affect the district 's:

5           (1) organization, existence, or validity;

6           (2) right to issue any type of bonds for the purposes  
7 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and  
8 interest on the bonds;

9           (3) right to impose or collect an assessment; or

10          (4) legality or operation.

11       Sec. 3796.0106. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.

12 All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be  
13 included in:

14           (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under  
15 Chapter 311, Tax Code; or

16           (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under  
17 Chapter 312, Tax Code.

18       Sec. 3796.0107. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT

19 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,  
20 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district.

21       Sec. 3796.0108. PRECONDITION. (a) The district may not

22 exercise any powers granted to the district by this chapter or other  
23 law unless a development agreement between the city and the primary  
24 landowner in the district that establishes the standards that apply  
25 to development in the district, in addition to those contained in  
26 zoning, subdivision, and other applicable ordinances of the city,  
27 has been executed.

1 (b) If a development agreement described by Subsection (a)  
2 has not been executed before September 1, 2024, the board shall  
3 dissolve the district in the manner provided by Subchapter I as soon  
4 as possible after September 1, 2024.

5 Sec. 3796.0109. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter  
6 shall be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and  
7 purposes stated in this chapter.

8 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

9 Sec. 3796.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is  
10 governed by a board of five elected directors who serve staggered  
11 terms of four years.

12 (b) Directors are elected in the manner provided by  
13 Subchapter D, Chapter 49, Water Code.

14 Sec. 3796.0202. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district  
15 may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$150 for  
16 each board meeting. The total amount of compensation for each  
17 director in one year may not exceed \$7,200.

18 (b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary  
19 and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and  
20 responsibilities of the board.

21 Sec. 3796.0203. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board  
22 consists of the following directors:

(b) Of the initial directors, the terms of directors appointed for positions one through three expire June 1, 2025, and the terms of directors appointed for positions four and five expire June 1, 2027.

SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

Sec. 3796.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for which the district is created.

Sec. 3796.0302. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. (a) The district, using any money available to the district for the purpose, may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve, relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or service authorized under a development agreement described by Section 3796.0108, under this chapter, or under Chapter 375, Local Government Code.

(b) The district may contract with a governmental or private entity to carry out an action under Subsection (a).

(c) The implementation of a district project or service is a governmental function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791, Government Code.

Sec. 3796.0303. NONPROFIT CORPORATION. (a) The board by resolution may authorize the creation of a nonprofit corporation to assist and act for the district in implementing a project or providing a service authorized by this chapter.

(b) The nonprofit corporation:

(1) has each power of and is considered to be a local

1 government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431,  
2 Transportation Code; and

3 (2) may implement any project and provide any service  
4 authorized by this chapter.

5 (c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of the  
6 nonprofit corporation. The board of directors of the nonprofit  
7 corporation shall serve in the same manner as the board of directors  
8 of a local government corporation created under Subchapter D,  
9 Chapter 431, Transportation Code, except that a board member is not  
10 required to reside in the district.

11 Sec. 3796.0304. MEMBERSHIP IN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.

12 The district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit  
13 organization that performs a service or provides an activity  
14 consistent with the furtherance of a district purpose.

15 Sec. 3796.0305. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may

16 acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own,  
17 operate, and maintain parking facilities or a system of parking  
18 facilities, including lots, garages, parking terminals, or other  
19 structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the  
20 streets and related appurtenances.

21 (b) The district 's parking facilities serve the public  
22 purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public  
23 purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of  
24 years.

25 (c) The district 's parking facilities are parts of and  
26 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street  
27 or road improvement.

1 (d) The development and operation of the district 's parking  
2 facilities may be considered an economic development program.

3 Sec. 3796.0306. ADDING OR EXCLUDING LAND. (a) Subject to  
4 Subsection (b), the district may add or exclude land in the manner  
5 provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code, or by Subchapter  
6 H, Chapter 54, Water Code.

7 (b) The district may add territory as described by  
8 Subsection (a) only if the governing body of the city by ordinance  
9 or resolution consents to the addition.

10 Sec. 3796.0307. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The  
11 board by resolution shall establish the number of directors '  
12 signatures and the procedure required for a disbursement or  
13 transfer of district money.

14 Sec. 3796.0308. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may  
15 be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:

16 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

17 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

18 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the  
19 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and  
20 duties of the district.

21 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district  
22 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land  
23 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this  
24 chapter.

25 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition  
26 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of  
27 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the

1 district.

2 (e) An order dividing the district must:

3 (1) name each new district;

4 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the  
5 territory of each new district;

6 (3) appoint initial directors for each new district;

7 and

8 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities  
9 between or among the new districts.

10 (f) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of  
11 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order  
12 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and record the  
13 order in the real property records of each county in which the  
14 district is located.

15 (g) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to  
16 the inclusion of land in the district granted under Section  
17 3796.0503 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new  
18 district created by the division of the district and to the  
19 inclusion of land in the new district.

20 Sec. 3796.0309. CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY NOT EXEMPT.  
21 Section 375.161, Local Government Code, does not apply to the  
22 district.

23 Sec. 3796.0310. NO AD VALOREM TAX. The district may not  
24 impose an ad valorem tax.

25 Sec. 3796.0311. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may  
26 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

SUBCHAPTER D. ASSESSMENTS

Sec. 3796.0401. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES AND IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement has been filed with the board.

(b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real property in the district subject to assessment according to the most recent certified tax appraisal roll for the county.

Sec. 3796.0402. ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment for any purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the district.

(b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney 's fees incurred by the district:

(1) are a first and prior lien against the property assessed;

(2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem taxes; and

(3) are the personal liability of and a charge against the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the assessment proceedings.

1       (c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's  
2 resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is  
3 paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that a  
4 taxing unit, as that term is defined by Section 1.04, Tax Code, may  
5 enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.

6       (d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the  
7 assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of  
8 any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in  
9 the manner required for additional assessments.

10                               SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

11       Sec. 3796.0501. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE  
12 BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on  
13 terms determined by the board.

14       (b) The district may issue, by public or private sale,  
15 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from  
16 assessments, revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district  
17 money, or any combination of those sources of money, to pay for any  
18 authorized district purpose.

19       (c) The district may issue, by public or private sale,  
20 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from  
21 assessments in the manner provided by Subchapter A, Chapter 372,  
22 Local Government Code, if the improvement financed by the  
23 obligation issued under this section will be conveyed to or  
24 operated and maintained by a municipality or other retail utility  
25 provider pursuant to an agreement with the district entered into  
26 before the issuance of the obligation.

27       Sec. 3796.0502. BONDS SECURED BY REVENUE OR CONTRACT

1 PAYMENTS. The district may issue, without an election, bonds  
2 secured by:

3 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes, including  
4 contract revenues; or

5 (2) contract payments, provided that the requirements  
6 of Section 49.108 , Water Code, have been met.

7 Sec. 3796.0503. CONSENT OF CITY REQUIRED. The board may not  
8 issue bonds until the city has consented by ordinance or resolution  
9 to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the  
10 district.

11 SUBCHAPTER I. DISSOLUTION

12 Sec. 3796.0901. DISSOLUTION. (a) The board shall dissolve  
13 the district on written petition filed with the board by the owners  
14 of:

15 (1) 66 percent or more of the assessed value subject to  
16 assessment by the district of the property in the district based on  
17 the most recent certified county property tax rolls; or

18 (2) 66 percent or more of the surface area of the  
19 district, excluding roads, streets, highways, utility  
20 rights-of-way, other public areas, and other property exempt from  
21 assessment by the district according to the most recent certified  
22 county property tax rolls.

23 (b) The district may not be dissolved if the district:

24 (1) has any outstanding bonded or other indebtedness  
25 until that bonded or other indebtedness has been repaid or defeased  
26 in accordance with the order or resolution authorizing the issuance  
27 of the bonded or other indebtedness;

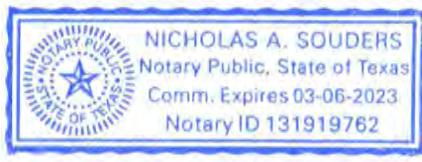
