- Amend C.S.S.B. No. 2627 (house committee printing) as
- 2 follows:
- 3 (1) On page 1, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:
- 4 SUBCHAPTER A. TEXAS ENERGY FUND; GRANTS AND LOANS
- 5 (2) On page 1, line 10, strike "chapter" and substitute
- 6 "subchapter".
- 7 (3) On page 13, between lines 11 and 12, insert the
- 8 following:
- 9 SUBCHAPTER B. TEXAS POWER PROMISE: BACKUP POWER PACKAGES
- 10 Sec. 34.0201. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "Texas backup
- 11 power package" means a stand-alone, behind-the-meter, multiday
- 12 backup power source that can be used for islanding.
- Sec. 34.0202. PURPOSE. The purpose of this subchapter is to
- 14 facilitate and provide funding for the design, procurement,
- 15 installation, and use of Texas backup power packages to ensure the
- 16 reliability or adequacy of an electric power grid in this state
- 17 for facilities on which communities rely for health, safety, and
- 18 well-being.
- 19 Sec. 34.0203. COMMISSION DUTIES. (a) The commission shall
- 20 convene an advisory committee in the manner provided by Chapter
- 21 2110, Government Code.
- 22 (b) The advisory committee shall recommend criteria for the
- 23 commission to employ in making a grant or loan under this
- 24 <u>subchapter</u>.
- 25 (c) The commission shall contract with a research entity

- 1 that has experience in microgrid design to analyze critical
- 2 <u>facility</u> characteristics and requirements in this state and
- 3 develop for Texas backup power packages:
- 4 (1) sets of specifications for standard backup power
- 5 packages of various sizes that can serve most critical facilities
- 6 in this state; and
- 7 (2) specifications for standard interconnection,
- 8 communications, and controls for Texas backup power packages.
- 9 Sec. 34.0204. TEXAS BACKUP POWER PACKAGES. The commission
- 10 may use money in the Texas energy fund without further
- 11 appropriation to provide a grant or loan for the operation of a
- 12 Texas backup power package that:
- 13 (1) is engineered to minimize operation costs;
- 14 (2) uses interconnection technology and controls that
- 15 enable immediate islanding from the power grid and stand-alone
- 16 operation for the host facility;
- 17 (3) is capable of operating for at least 48 continuous
- 18 hours without refueling or connecting to a separate power source;
- 19 <u>(4) is designed so that one or more Texas backup power</u>
- 20 packages can be aggregated on-site to serve not more than 2.5
- 21 megawatts of load at the host facility;
- 22 (5) provides power sourced from:
- 23 (A) a combination of natural gas or propane with
- 24 photovoltaic panels and battery storage; or
- 25 (B) battery storage on an electric school bus; and
- 26 (6) is not used by the owner or host facility for the
- 27 <u>sale of energy or ancillary services.</u>

- Sec. 34.0205. GRANTS AND LOANS. (a) The commission by rule
- 2 may establish procedures for the application for and award of a
- 3 grant or loan under this subchapter.
- 4 (b) The amount of a grant provided under this subchapter may
- 5 not exceed \$500 per kilowatt of capacity.
- 6 (c) The commission may provide a loan under this subchapter
- 7 for procurement and operating costs.
- 8 (d) The commission shall maintain and publish a list of
- 9 approved vendors eligible to assist with the sale, installation,
- 10 operation, and ongoing maintenance of Texas backup power packages.
- 11 (e) The commission may not provide a grant or loan under
- 12 this subchapter for:
- 13 (1) a commercial energy system, a private school, or a
- 14 for-profit entity that does not directly serve public safety and
- 15 human health; or
- 16 (2) a source of backup power that does not follow the
- 17 design and use standards of a Texas backup power package.
- 18 (4) On page 13, line 14, between "(d)" and "The" insert "This
- 19 subsection applies only to a facility in the ERCOT power region
- 20 for which a loan or grant is provided under Subchapter A, Chapter
- 21 34."
- 22 (5) Strike "under Chapter 34" in each of the following
- 23 places:
- 24 (A) page 13, line 17;
- 25 (B) page 13, line 22;
- 26 (C) page 13, line 25;
- 27 (D) page 13, line 27; and

- 1 (E) page 14, line 8.
- 2 (6) On page 14, lines 11-12, strike "for which a loan or
- 3 grant is provided under Chapter 34" and substitute "to which
- 4 Subsection (d) applies".
- 5 (7) On page 14, line 23, between "authorized by" and Chapter
- 6 34", insert "Subchapter A,".
- 7 (8) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the
- 8 bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 9 SECTION . Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.069 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 382.069. TEXAS BACKUP POWER PACKAGE. (a) In this
- 12 section, "Texas backup power package" has the meaning assigned by
- 13 Section 34.0201, Utilities Code.
- 14 (b) The commission by rule shall adopt a process to expedite
- 15 the permitting of a Texas backup power package for which a permit
- 16 is required under this chapter and for which a loan or grant is
- 17 awarded under Chapter 34, Utilities Code.
- SECTION \_\_\_\_. Subchapter Z, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 39.919 to read as follows:
- Sec. 39.919. TEXAS BACKUP POWER PACKAGES. (a) In this
- 21 section, "Texas backup power package" has the meaning assigned by
- 22 Section 34.0201.
- 23 (b) The commission by rule shall adopt procedures to
- 24 expedite electric cooperative, municipally owned utility, and
- 25 electric utility interconnection requests for a Texas backup power
- 26 package for which a loan or grant is awarded under Chapter 34.
