Amend C.S.S.B. No. 2627 (house committee printing) 1 (1) On page 7, line 23, between "(1)" and "The commission" 2 follows: 3 insert the following: new appropriately lettered subsection 4 The commission may not provide a grant under this section to an entity that has received a loan under Section 34.0104. 6 7 <u>(h)</u> On page 7, line 25 strike "provide" and substitute "make 8 9 (3) On page 7, between lines 24 and 25, insert the following: 10 (i) The commission shall provide for the proceeds of each 11 grant awarded under this section to be disbursed to the grant 12 recipient by equal annual payments over a 10-year period that 13 begins on the first anniversary of the commercial operations date 14 of the facility for which the grant is provided. The annual 15 payments are subject to being withheld or discounted in accordance 16 17 with Subsection (j). The total of the annual disbursements may not exceed the maximum amount as limited by Subsection (f). 18 (j) The commission by rule shall establish performance 19 standards for grant recipients based on reliability metrics, 20 21 appropriate for the types of facilities for which grants may be provided, for performance during the 100 hours with the least 22 quantity of operating reserves for each year. The commission may 23 not disburse a grant recipient's annual payment under Subsection 24

(i) if the performance of the facility for which the grant was

- 1 provided is equal to or below the median performance standard
- 2 <u>established under this subsection during a test period designated</u>
- 3 by the commission for that year. The commission may disburse a
- 4 discounted amount of a grant recipient's annual payment under
- 5 Subsection (i) if the performance of the facility for which the
- 6 grant was provided is above the median performance standard
- 7 established under this subsection during a test period designated
- 8 by the commission for that year but less than an optimal
- 9 performance standard established by the commission. The commission
- shall by rule adopt a system for determining the amount by which
- 11 the commission will discount an annual payment based on facility
- 12 performance under this subsection.
- 13 (4) On page 8, strike lines 6-10 and insert the following:
- 14 (c) The commission shall require each recipient of a loan
- 15 under this chapter to enter into a debt covenant that requires the
- 16 <u>recipient to meet facility performance standards adopted by the</u>
- 17 commission. The commission by rule shall adopt performance
- 18 standards for the purposes of this subsection based on reliability
- 19 metrics appropriate for the types of facilities for which loans
- 20 may be provided.
- 21 (d) Before December 1, 2026, the commission may provide:
- 22 (1) for grants under Section 34.0103, not more than 15
- 23 percent of the money available in the fund on December 1, 2023;
- 24 (2) for loans and grants under Sections 34.0104 and
- 25 34.0105, not more than 60 percent of the money available in the
- fund on December 1, 2023; and
- 27 (3) for grants or loans under Subchapter B, not more

- 1 than 25 percent of the money available in the fund on December 1,
- 2 2023.
- 3 (5) On page 8, line 11, strike "(d) Subsection (c)" and
- 4 substitute "(e) Subsection (d)".
