Amend **CSHB 2818** (house committee report) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION ____. Section 122.102, Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 122.102. LICENSE <u>AND HEMP RESEARCH PERMIT</u> INELIGIBILITY. (a) An individual who is or has been convicted of a felony relating to a controlled substance under federal law or the law of any state may not, before the 10th anniversary of the date of the conviction:

 (1) hold a license under this subchapter <u>or a hemp</u> research permit under Subchapter A; or

(2) be a governing person of a business entity <u>or</u> <u>nonprofit research entity</u> that holds a license under this subchapter <u>or a hemp research permit under Subchapter A</u>.

(b) The department may not issue a license under this subchapter <u>or a hemp research permit under Subchapter A</u> to a person who materially falsifies any information contained in an application submitted to the department under Section <u>122.005 or</u> 122.103.
