1	Amend C.S.H.B. 1 (house committee printing) in ARTICLE I of
2	the bill, following the appropriations to the Employees Retirement
3	System (page I-39), by adding the following appropriately numbered
4	rider:
5	Prohibition on Use of General Revenue for Gender
6	Transitioning or Reassignment Procedures or Treatments for Minors.
7	(a) General Revenue appropriated by this Act to the
8	Employees Retirement System may not be used to pay for the
9	provision of gender transitioning or gender reassignment
10	procedures and treatments to minors for the purpose of
11	transitioning a minor's biological sex organs and endogenous
12	profiles or affirming the minor's perception of the minor's sex if
13	that perception is inconsistent with the minor's biological sex.
14	Specifically, the money may not be used to:
15	(1) perform a surgery that sterilizes the minor,
16	including:
17	(A) castration;
18	(B) vasectomy;
19	(C) hysterectomy;
20	(D) oophorectomy;
21	(E) metoidioplasty;
22	(F) orchiectomy;
23	(G) penectomy;
24	(H) phalloplasty; and
25	(I) vaginoplasty;

1 (2) perform: 2 a mastectomy on a female; or 3 a breast augmentation on a male; prescribe, administer, or supply any of the 4 5 following medications that induce transient or permanent infertility: 6 7 (A) puberty-blocking medication to stop or delay 8 normal puberty; 9 supraphysiologic doses of testosterone to (B) females; or 10 11 (C) supraphysiologic doses of estrogen to males; 12 or 13 (4) remove any otherwise healthy or non-diseased body 14 part or tissue. (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to the provision by a 15 16 physician or health care provider, with the consent of the minor's parent or legal guardian, of appropriate and medically necessary 17 18 gender transitioning or gender reassignment procedures or 19 treatments to a minor who: 20 (1) is born with a medically verifiable genetic disorder of sex development, including: 21 22 46, XX chromosomes with virilization; (A) 46,XY chromosomes with undervirilization; or 23 (B) 24 both ovarian and testicular tissue; or

for male or female as determined by a physician through genetic
