- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. 1 (house committee printing) in Article III of
- 2 the bill, following the appropriations to the Teacher Retirement
- 3 System (page III-39), by adding the following appropriately
- 4 numbered rider:
- 5 \_\_\_\_. Study and Report on Alternative Service Retirement
- 6 Benefits for Peace Officers. (a) It is the intent of the legislature
- 7 that, out of funds appropriated to the Teacher Retirement System
- 8 above, the retirement system conduct a study on the feasibility of
- 9 offering alternative service retirement benefits under the system
- 10 to members of the system who are peace officers.
- 11 (b) In conducting the study, the Teacher Retirement System
- 12 shall assess the costs to and impact on the retirement system
- 13 associated with offering members of the retirement system who are
- 14 peace officers the following alternative service retirement
- 15 benefits:
- 16 (1) a supplemental benefit for peace officers that is
- 17 substantially similar in design and cost structure to the
- 18 supplemental retirement benefit payable from the law enforcement
- 19 and custodial officer supplemental retirement fund established
- 20 under Section 815.317, Government Code; and
- 21 (2) a service retirement benefit under a cash balance
- 22 benefit plan that is substantially similar in design and cost
- 23 structure to the cash balance benefit plan established under
- 24 Chapter 820, Government Code, and provides retirement eligibility
- 25 at any age after the member attains 20 or 25 years of service.
- 26 (c) Not later than March 1, 2024, an employer who employs
- 27 members of the Teacher Retirement System who are peace officers
- 28 shall submit the following information to the retirement system:
- 29 (1) the number of peace officers employed by the

- 1 employer on December 31, 2023;
- 2 (2) the number of unfilled peace officer positions on
- 3 December 31, 2023;
- 4 (3) for the 10-year period preceding December 31,
- 5 2023, the average years of service earned by peace officers who
- 6 resigned before retirement; and
- 7 (4) the compensation or salary scale for peace
- 8 officers employed by the employer.
- 9 (d) Not later than December 31, 2024, the Teacher Retirement
- 10 System shall prepare and submit a report to the legislature that
- 11 contains the findings of the study conducted under this rider and a
- 12 summary of the information submitted to the retirement system under
- 13 Subsection (c) of this rider.
