1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article II

2 of the bill by adding the following appropriately numbered rider

3 following the appropriations to the Department of Family and

- 4 Protective Services (page II-3):
- 5 ____. Family First Prevention Services. (a) Out of federal
- 6 funds appropriated to the Department of Family and Protective
- 7 Services above, the department shall allocate the sum of
- 8 \$19,300,000 for the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1,
- 9 2023, for the following purposes:
- 10 (1) the provision of family preservation services
- 11 subject to the Family First Prevention Services Act (Title VII,
- 12 Div. E, Pub. L. No. 115-123), including services for foster youth
- 13 who are homeless;
- 14 (2) the provision of services and interventions for
- 15 children who are at imminent risk of being removed from their homes
- 16 and placed into the conservatorship of the department but for whom a
- 17 court of competent jurisdiction has issued an order allowing the
- 18 children to remain safely in their homes or in kinship placements
- 19 with the provision of family preservation services;
- 20 (3) the provision of services to pregnant women or
- 21 mothers with substance use disorders and their children, children
- 22 who are at imminent risk of being removed from their homes and
- 23 placed into the conservatorship of the department because their
- 24 parents refuse to accept parental responsibility and those
- 25 children's families, children who are at risk of being referred to
- 26 the department through the juvenile justice system and their
- 27 families, and children who have exited foster care through
- 28 adoption, reunification, or other permanency outcomes and their
- 29 families; and

- 1 (4) the transition of family preservation services to
- 2 evidence-based services consistent with the Family First
- 3 Prevention Services Act.
- 4 (b) Not later than March 31 and September 30 of each year of
- 5 the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2023, the
- 6 Department of Family and Protective Services shall prepare and
- 7 submit a report to the governor, the Legislative Budget Board, the
- 8 House Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Finance,
- 9 the House Committee on Human Services, the Senate Committee on
- 10 Health and Human Services, and any appropriate standing joint
- 11 legislative oversight committee regarding the department's
- 12 progress toward increasing the capacity of qualifying
- 13 community-based prevention and family preservation services. The
- 14 department shall:
- 15 (1) prepare the report in a format specified by the
- 16 Legislative Budget Board and include a full accounting of funds
- 17 expended under this section; and
- 18 (2) post the report on the department's Internet
- 19 website.
