| 15 | or experiences an involuntary miscarriage; and                       |
| 16 | (2) 12 months that begins on the last day of the                     |
| 17 | woman's pregnancy and ends on the last day of the month in which the |
| 18 | 12-month period ends in accordance with Section 1902(e)(16), Social  |
| 19 | Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(e)(16)).                       |
| 20 | SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date           |
| 21 | of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human      |
| 22 | Services Commission shall, in accordance with Section 1902(e)(16),   |
| 23 | Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(e)(16)), seek from the  |
| 24 | appropriate federal agency an amendment to the state's Medicaid      |

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state plan to implement Section 32.024(l-1)(2), Human Resources Code, as added by this Act. The commission may delay implementing this Act until the state plan amendment is approved.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
