- 7 (d) The exception to disclosure provided by Subsection
- 8 (a)(2) does not apply to information, records, or notations if:
- 9 <u>(1) a person who is described by or depicted in the</u>
- 10 information, record, or notation, other than a peace officer, is
- 11 deceased or incapacitated; or
- 12 (2) each person who is described by or depicted in the
- 13 information, record, or notation, other than a person who is
- 14 deceased or incapacitated, consents to the release of the
- 15 information, record, or notation.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a request for public information received by a governmental body
- 18 or an officer for public information on or after the effective date
- 19 of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
