Subtitle A, Title 3, Natural Resources Code, is amended by adding Chapter 82 to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 82. ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL LAWS 7 Sec. 82.0101. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "oil and gas 8 9 operation" has the meaning assigned by Section 81.0523. Sec. 82.0102. ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN FEDERAL LAWS 10 REGULATING OIL AND GAS OPERATIONS. (a) An agency of this state or a 11 person employed by an agency of this state may not contract with or 12 in any other manner provide assistance to a federal agency or 13 14 official with respect to the enforcement of a federal statute, order, rule, or regulation purporting to regulate oil and gas 15 operations if the statute, order, rule, or regulation imposes a 16 prohibition, restriction, or other regulation that does not exist 17 under the laws of this state. 18 (b) The attorney general shall defend any agency of this 19 state that the federal government attempts to sue for an action or 20 21 omission consistent with the requirements of this section. 22 (c) This section does not prohibit a state agency from 23 entering into a memorandum of agreement with a federal agency to

implement a federal law if otherwise authorized by state law,

<u>including a memorandum of agreement that authorizes the state</u>
 <u>agency to execute authority delegated to that state agency by the</u>
 <u>federal agency.</u>
 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
