4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 7, Transportation Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 526 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 526. DIGITAL IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM
8	Sec. 526.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Department" and "driver's license" have the
10	meanings assigned by Section 521.001.
11	(2) "Digital identification" includes digital
12	driver's licenses and digital personal identification
13	certificates.
14	Sec. 526.0102. DIGITAL IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM. (a) The
15	department by rule shall establish a program for the issuance of
16	digital identification.
17	(b) In establishing the digital identification program, the
18	department shall:
19	(1) assess existing department infrastructure and
20	upgrade department infrastructure according to the department's
21	findings;
22	(2) acquire a mobile application that:
23	(A) displays digital identification that
24	includes the information described by Section 521.121(a) on a

- 1 wireless communication device;
- 2 (B) includes an authentication and verification
- 3 process for a wireless communication device; and
- 4 (C) may be used in any location regardless of the
- 5 location's level of wireless connectivity or cellular telephone
- 6 service;
- 7 (3) deploy the digital identification mobile
- 8 application; and
- 9 (4) implement a law enforcement version of the
- 10 application.
- 11 (c) The department may contract with a third party to
- 12 establish the program described by this section if the contract is
- 13 at no cost to the department.
- 14 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt the
- 15 rules for the digital identification program under Chapter 526,
- 16 Transportation Code, as added by this Act, not later than February
- 17 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
