19	section, "retired classroom teacher" means a person who:
20	(1) was formerly employed as a classroom teacher, as
21	that term is defined by Section 5.001, Education Code; and
22	(2) is a retiree of the Teacher Retirement System of
23	Texas.
24	(b) The department shall issue specialty license plates for

1 retired classroom teachers with at least 20 years of service

2 <u>teaching public school students</u>. The license plates must include

3 the words "Retired Texas Teacher" and depict a Texas public
