- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Title 6, Utilities Code, is

- 7 TITLE 6. PRIVATELY ENFORCEABLE RENEWABLE GENERATION PROVISIONS
- 8 [PRIVATE POWER ACREEMENTS]
- 9 SECTION 2. Title 6, Utilities Code, is amended by adding
- 10 Chapter 303 to read as follows:
- 11 CHAPTER 303. WIND TURBINE GENERATOR SITING
- Sec. 303.0101. SITING. (a) A person may not construct at a
- 13 site a wind turbine generator unless the site complies with the
- 14 minimum setback requirements provided by this section.
- 15 (b) The minimum setback for a wind turbine generator is
- 16 3,000 feet measured from the property line of each property that
- 17 borders the property on which the site is located.
- 18 (c) The setback distance described by Subsection (b) must be
- 19 measured as a straight line from the vertical centerline of the
- 20 proposed wind turbine generator to the nearest point on the
- 21 property line.
- 22 (d) This section does not create an offense.
- Sec. 303.0102. SITING WAIVER. (a) A person may begin
- 24 construction of a wind turbine generator at a site that does not

- 1 comply with the requirements of Section 303.0101 if the person
- 2 obtains a signed, written waiver from the owner of the property that
- 3 is the source of the noncompliance.
- 4 (b) A waiver may not be made effective for a period of more
- 5 than one year after the date the owner signs the waiver. A waiver
- 6 may be retroactive for any period of time.
- 7 <u>Sec. 303.0103. INJUNCTION. (a) A county or district court</u>
- 8 by injunction may prevent, restrain, abate, or otherwise remedy a
- 9 violation of this chapter.
- 10 (b) A person affected or who may be affected by a violation
- 11 or threatened violation of this chapter may bring suit under
- 12 Subsection (a).
- SECTION 3. Chapter 240, Local Government Code, is amended
- 14 by adding Subchapter F to read as follows:
- 15 <u>SUBCHAPTER F. WIND-POWERED ENERGY DEVICES</u>
- Sec. 240.101. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 17 (1) "Air navigation facility" and "airport" have the
- 18 meanings assigned by Section 22.001, Transportation Code.
- 19 (2) "Wind-powered energy device" means an apparatus
- 20 designed or adapted to:
- 21 (A) convert the energy available in the wind into
- 22 thermal, mechanical, or electrical energy;
- (B) store the energy converted under Paragraph
- 24 (A), either in the form to which originally converted or another
- 25 <u>form; or</u>
- 26 (C) distribute the energy converted under
- 27 Paragraph (A).

- 1 Sec. 240.102. DESIGNATION OF CONSTRUCTION AREAS. (a) The
- 2 commissioners court of a county in which an air navigation facility
- 3 or airport is located by order may, in collaboration with the owner
- 4 or operator of the facility or airport:
- 5 (1) designate one or more appropriate locations for a
- 6 person to install a wind-powered energy device in the
- 7 unincorporated area of the county in accordance with this section;
- 8 and
- 9 (2) prohibit the installation of a wind-powered energy
- 10 device in the county in an area other than a designated area.
- 11 (b) An order under Subsection (a) may not apply to a
- 12 wind-powered energy device installed before the effective date of
- 13 the order.
- 14 (c) Areas designated by a county under Subsection (a) must
- 15 maintain compatibility with the activities of the air navigation
- 16 facility or airport.
- 17 SECTION 4. Chapter 303, Utilities Code, as added by this
- 18 Act, applies only to a wind turbine generator the construction of
- 19 which begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 Construction of a wind turbine generator that began before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 22 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 23 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
