## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to testing possible controlled substance evidence for
- 3 fentanyl.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 38.51 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 38.51. EVIDENCE TESTING FOR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES. If
- 8 evidence that may be a controlled substance is submitted to a
- 9 <u>laboratory for testing and it is reasonably possible that the</u>
- 10 substance is or contains fentanyl, a test must be performed
- 11 following validated laboratory procedures and sampling protocols
- 12 to determine whether the substance is or contains fentanyl.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to evidence submitted for testing on or after the effective date of
- 15 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
