A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to requiring a court that sets an execution date to
3 withdraw the execution date on the motion of the prosecuting
4 attorney with jurisdiction over the underlying case.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Article [43.141](#), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
7 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

8 (d-1) The convicting court shall withdraw the order of the
9 court setting a date for execution in a death penalty case on the
10 motion of the attorney representing the state.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
