- 6 SECTION 1. Section 375.262, Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 375.262. DISSOLUTION BY PETITION BY OWNERS. (a)
- 9 Except as limited by Section 375.264, the board shall dissolve the
- 10 district on written petition filed with the board by the owners of
- 11 the majority [at least two-thirds] of the assessed value of the
- 12 property subject to assessment or taxation by the district based on
- 13 the most recent certified county property tax rolls.
- 14 (b) In all areas of conflict the provisions of this section
- 15 take precedence over a special law governing a district.
- SECTION 2. Section 68.352(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (b) A district may be dissolved as provided by Section
- 19 375.262, Local Government Code, except that the written petition
- 20 must be filed by the owners of at least two-thirds of the assessed
- 21 value of the property subject to assessment or taxation by the
- 22 district based on the most recent certified county property tax
- 23 rolls.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

- 1 a petition described by Section 375.262, Local Government Code,
- 2 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A petition filed
- 3 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 4 effect on the date the petition was filed, and the former law is
- 5 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
