Sections 241.012(c), (g), and (i), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a hospital may during a qualifying period of disaster: 8 (1) restrict the 9 number of visitors а patient receiving care or treatment at the hospital may receive at any one 10 time to not fewer than one; 11 12 (2) require a visitor to the hospital to: 13 complete a health screening before entering (A) 14 the hospital; and 15 (B) wear personal protective equipment at all times while visiting a patient at the hospital; and 16 (3) deny entry to or remove from the hospital's 17 premises a visitor who fails or refuses to: 18 (A) submit to or meet the requirements of a 19 health screening administered by the hospital; or 20 21 (B) wear personal protective equipment that 22 meets the hospital's infection control and safety requirements in 23 the manner prescribed by the hospital. (g) A determination made by an attending physician under 24

Subsection (f)(2) <u>must be in writing and</u> is valid for not more than
<u>48 hours</u> [five days] after [the date] the determination is made
unless renewed by an attending physician. <u>A renewal of the</u>
<u>determination must be in writing, is valid for not more than 48</u>
<u>hours after the renewal is made, and may be renewed in the same</u>
manner as the initial determination.

(i) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a
hospital may not prohibit in-person visitation by a religious
counselor <u>of the patient's choosing</u> with a patient who is receiving
care or treatment at the hospital [and who is seriously ill or
dying] for a reason other than the religious counselor's failure to
comply with a requirement described by Subsection (c)(2).
