A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to requirements for fireworks sales buildings of indoor

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E-1, Chapter 2154, Occupations Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 2154.2215 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2154.2215. FIREWORKS SALES BUILDINGS IN CERTAIN
- 8 COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a county with a
- 9 population of more than 1.5 million in which more than 75 percent of
- 10 the population lives in a single municipality.
- 11 (b) In addition to the requirements of Section 2154.221, a
- 12 fireworks sales building of an indoor retail fireworks site located
- 13 in or directly adjacent to a residential real estate subdivision
- 14 with at least 3,300 homes that is governed by a property owners
- 15 association must:
- 16 (1) be, at the time the building's construction
- 17 commences, a minimum distance of 100 feet from any inhabited
- 18 building;
- 19 (2) have, at a minimum, one-hour fire-rated exterior
- 20 walls with minimum three-fourths-hour fire-rated protected
- 21 openings; and
- 22 (3) have a complete automatic fire sprinkler system
- 23 installed in accordance with the provisions of the edition of the
- 24 National Fire Protection Association, Standard 13, "Standard for

- 1 the Installation of Sprinkler Systems," as adopted and amended by
- 2 the commissioner.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2154.2215, Occupations Code, as added by
- 4 this Act, applies only to a fireworks sales building of an indoor
- 5 retail fireworks site for which construction commences on or after
- 6 September 1, 2023. A fireworks sales building of an indoor retail
- 7 fireworks site for which construction commenced before that date is
- 8 governed by the law in effect before September 1, 2023, and the
- 9 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
