- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2154.221, Occupations Code, is amended
- to read as follows:
- Sec. 2154.221. FIREWORKS SALES 7 BUILDING. (a) The
- fireworks sales building of an indoor retail fireworks site must: 8
- 9 (1) be a freestanding durable structure with only one
- story of the building accessible to the public $\underline{\boldsymbol{i}}$ 10
- 11 (2) be, at the time the building's construction
- 12 commences, a minimum distance of 100 feet from any inhabited
- 13 building;

- 14 (3) have, at a minimum, one-hour fire-rated exterior
- walls with minimum three-fourths-hour fire-rated protected 15
- 16 openings; and
- (4) have a complete automatic fire sprinkler system 17
- installed in accordance with the provisions of the edition of the 18
- National Fire Protection Association, Standard 13, "Standard for 19
- the Installation of Sprinkler Systems," as adopted and amended by 20
- 21 the commissioner.
- (b) The fireworks sales building of an indoor retail 22
- 23 fireworks site may not be:
- 24 (1) a tent, boat, or mobile vehicle; or

- 1 (2) part of a multiuse or multi-tenant building.
- 2 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a fireworks sales building of an indoor retail fireworks site for
- 4 which construction commences on or after September 1, 2023. A
- 5 fireworks sales building of an indoor retail fireworks site for
- 6 which construction commenced before that date is governed by the
- 7 law in effect before September 1, 2023, and the former law is
- 8 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
