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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the days and hours during which the polls are open for early voting by personal appearance. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.004(d), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (d) The [If early voting by personal appearance is required to be conducted for extended hours under Section 85.005(c) or for 8 weekend hours under Section 85.006(e), the] registrar's office 9 shall remain open for providing voter registration information 10 during the [extended hours or weekend] hours that the main early 11 12 voting polling place is open for voting. SECTION 2. Sections 85.001(a) and (e), Election Code, are 13 14 amended to read as follows: The period for early voting by personal appearance 15 (a) 16 begins on the 17th day before election day and continues through the fourth day before election day, except as otherwise provided by 17 this <u>subchapter</u> [section]. 18 For an election held on the uniform election date in May 19 (e) and any resulting runoff election, the period for early voting by 20 personal appearance begins on the 12th day before election day and 21 continues through the fourth day before election day, except as 22 23 otherwise provided by this subchapter.

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SECTION 3. Section 85.006, Election Code, is amended to

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1 read as follows:

2 Sec. 85.006. <u>EXTENDED</u> VOTING [ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY]. (a) 3 Except as provided by Subsection (b), the authority ordering an 4 election may order early voting by personal appearance at the main 5 early voting polling place to be conducted:

6 (1) on one or more Saturdays or Sundays during the 7 early voting period; or

8 (2) during an early voting period extended from the 9 fourth day before election day for any number of consecutive days up 10 to and including the day before election day.

(b) In an election in which a county clerk is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002, only the early voting clerk may order <u>extended</u> voting [on a Saturday or Sunday]. The clerk must do so by written order.

15 (c) <u>Except as otherwise provided by this section, the</u> [<del>The</del>] 16 authority ordering <u>extended</u> voting [<del>on a Saturday or Sunday</del>] shall 17 determine the hours during which voting is to be conducted.

The authority authorized to order extended early voting 18 (d) [on a Saturday or Sunday] under Subsection (a) or (b) shall order 19 [the] voting on a Saturday or Sunday under the applicable 20 subsection on receipt of a written request submitted by at least 15 21 registered voters of the territory covered by the election. 22 The 23 request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 24 85.007. The authority is not required to order the voting on a particular date specified by the request but shall order the voting 25 26 on at least one Saturday if a Saturday is requested and on at least one Sunday if a Sunday is requested. 27

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1 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state and county officers in a county with a population of 55,000 or more, 2 3 the early voting clerk shall order voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place to be conducted on the last 4 5 Saturday of the early voting period for at least 12 hours, except that voting may not be conducted earlier than 6 a.m. or later than 6 10 p.m., and on the last Sunday of the early voting period for at 7 8 least six hours, except that voting may not be conducted earlier than 9 a.m. or later than 10 p.m. The early voting clerk shall order 9 voting to be conducted at those times in those elections in a county 10 with a population under 55,000 on receipt of a written request for 11 12 those hours submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in time to enable compliance 13 14 with Section 85.007. This subsection supersedes any provision of 15 this subchapter to the extent of any conflict.

16 (f) An authority authorized to order extended early voting 17 under Subsection (a) or (b) that orders the voting during an 18 extended early voting period shall order personal appearance voting 19 at the main early voting polling place to be conducted for at least 20 12 hours on any weekday or Saturday and for at least five hours on 21 any Sunday of the extended early voting period.

22 SECTION 4. Sections 85.007(a) and (b), Election Code, are 23 amended to read as follows:

(a) The election order and the election notice must state:
(1) the date that early voting will begin if under
Section 85.001(d) the early voting period is to begin later than the
prescribed date;

H.B. No. 317 (2) the regular dates and hours that voting will be conducted under Section 85.005(b); and

3 (3) the dates and hours that <u>extended</u> voting [<del>on</del> 4 <u>Saturday or Sunday</u>] is ordered to be conducted under Section 5 85.006(a).

6 (b) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each 7 election stating the dates and hours that <u>extended</u> voting [<del>on a</del> 8 <del>Saturday or Sunday</del>] is ordered to be conducted under Section 9 85.006(b).

10 SECTION 5. Section 85.064(d), Election Code, is amended to 11 read as follows:

The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order 12 (d) extended early voting [on a Saturday or Sunday] may also order, in 13 14 the manner prescribed by that section, extended early voting to be 15 conducted [on a Saturday or Sunday] at any one or more of the temporary branch polling places. In addition, the early voting 16 17 clerk of a county covered by Section 85.006(e) shall order such voting in accordance with that subsection at each temporary branch 18 polling place established under Section 85.062(d). 19

20 SECTION 6. Section 85.065(b), Election Code, is amended to 21 read as follows:

(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), voting at a temporary branch polling place may be conducted on any days and during any hours of the period for early voting by personal appearance, as determined by the authority establishing the branch. The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order <u>extended</u> early voting [on a Saturday or Sunday] may also order, in the manner

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1 prescribed by that section, <u>extended</u> early voting to be conducted 2 [on a Saturday or Sunday] at any one or more of the temporary branch 3 polling places.

4 SECTION 7. Section 85.068(a), Election Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

(a) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
election stating any dates and the hours that <u>extended</u> voting [<del>on</del>
<del>Saturday or Sunday</del>] will be conducted under Section 85.064(d) or
85.065(b), if the early voting clerk is a county clerk or city
secretary under Section 83.002 or 83.005.

11 SECTION 8. Section 87.0241, Election Code, is amended by 12 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 13 follows:

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(b) The board may not count early voting ballots until:

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(1) the polls open on election day; or

16 (2) in an election conducted by an authority of a 17 county with a population of 100,000 or more, or conducted jointly 18 with such a county or conducted with such a county through a 19 contract for election services, the <u>time the polls close on the</u> 20 <u>fourth day before election day</u> [end of the period for early voting 21 <u>by personal appearance</u>].

22 (b-1) The board may not count early voting ballots voted by
23 personal appearance after the fourth day before election day until
24 the end of the extended early voting period.

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SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
