7	CHAPTER 205. REPORTS OF CERTAIN FIREARM TRANSFERS
8	Sec. 205.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "licensed
9	firearms dealer" means a person who is licensed as a firearms dealer
10	under 18 U.S.C. Section 923.
11	Sec. 205.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
12	a semiautomatic rifle that:
13	(1) is capable of accepting a detachable magazine; and
14	(2) has a caliber greater than .22.
15	Sec. 205.003. REPORT. A licensed firearms dealer who sells
16	or otherwise transfers a semiautomatic rifle described by Section
17	205.002 to a person who is under 21 years of age promptly shall
18	report the transfer to the sheriff of the county in which the
19	transfer occurred.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to the sale or other transfer of a firearm that occurs on or after
22	the effective date of this Act. A sale or other transfer of a
