A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-21 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the requirements to access the online tracker of an 1-24 application for a ballot to be voted by mail.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 86.015(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:

- The online tool developed or provided under Subsection (b)
- (a) must require the voter to provide, before permitting the voter to access information described by that subsection:

 (1) the voter's name and date of birth [registration address] and the last four digits of the voter's social security number; and
 - (2)the voter's:
 - driver's license number; or (A)
- 1-36 (B) personal identification card number issued 1-37 by the Department of Public Safety.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
