## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use, possession, delivery, or manufacture of
- 3 testing equipment that identifies the presence of fentanyl,
- 4 alpha-methylfentanyl, or any other derivative of fentanyl.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 481.125, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 8 (j) This section does not apply to a person who uses,
- 9 possesses with the intent to use, delivers, possesses with intent
- 10 to deliver, or manufactures with intent to deliver testing
- 11 equipment that identifies the presence of fentanyl,
- 12 <u>alpha-methylfentanyl</u>, or any other derivative of fentanyl.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed,
- 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 18 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 19 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 20 before that date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
