## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the date on which certain persons placed on deferred 3 adjudication community supervision are eligible to file a petition 4 for an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record 5 information.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 411.0725(e), Government Code, is amended 8 to read as follows:

9 (e) A person may petition the court that placed the person 10 on deferred adjudication community supervision for an order of 11 nondisclosure of criminal history record information under this 12 section only on or after:

13 (1) the discharge and dismissal, if the offense for 14 which the person was placed on deferred adjudication was a 15 misdemeanor other than a misdemeanor described by Subdivision 16 (2)(A) [(2)];

17 (2) the <u>first</u> [second] anniversary of the discharge 18 and dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on 19 deferred adjudication was<u>:</u>

20 <u>(A)</u> a misdemeanor under Chapter 20, 21, 22, 25, 21 42, 43, or 46, Penal Code; or

(B) a state jail felony listed in Article
42A.551(a), Code of Criminal Procedure; or

24 (3) the <u>third</u> [<del>fifth</del>] anniversary of the discharge and

1 dismissal, if the offense for which the person was placed on 2 deferred adjudication was a felony <u>other than a state jail felony</u> 3 <u>described by Subdivision (2)(B)</u>.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
