A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the award of library construction grants by the Texas 3 State Library and Archives Commission. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 441.135(b), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 The program of grants shall include one or more of the 7 (b) following: 8 9 (1) system operation grants, to: (A) provide basic system support services to 10 11 member libraries; 12 (B) provide coordination and enable cooperation 13 with the commission and with other libraries in a region; and 14 (C) meet commission and federal goals; (2) 15 incentive grants, to encourage public libraries to join together into larger units of service to meet commission and 16 federal goals; 17 establishment grants, to help libraries establish 18 (3) consortia or cooperatives that will enable libraries to better 19 serve their communities; 20 21 (4) equalization grants, to help public libraries in 22 communities with relatively limited taxable resources to meet commission and federal goals and qualify for library system 23 24 membership;

1 (5) public information technology grants, to help 2 public libraries make state, local, and federal government 3 information that is accessible through the Internet available to 4 the public through computers;

5 (6) competitive grants, to promote innovation by 6 public libraries and by libraries described by Section 441.1271(a) 7 and to encourage major resource systems or regional library systems 8 and libraries to meet commission and federal goals; [and]

9 (7) grants to aid local libraries, to provide 10 assistance to public libraries, and to help those libraries meet 11 commission and federal goals<u>; and</u>

12 <u>(8) construction grants, to encourage the</u> 13 <u>establishment of new public libraries or the improvement of</u> 14 <u>existing public libraries</u>.

15 SECTION 2. Section 441.138, Government Code, is amended by 16 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 17 follows:

(b) Libraries and library systems may use state grants for:
 <u>(1)</u> materials;

20 <u>(2)</u> [7] personnel;

21 (3) [7] equipment;

22 (4) [7] administrative expenses;

23 (5) new construction, rehabilitation, or renovation
24 of a library or the infrastructure of a library and associated
25 expenses; [--] and

26 (6) financing programs that enrich the services and 27 materials offered a community by its public library.

<u>(b-1)</u> State grants may not be used for site acquisition,
 [construction,] acquisition of buildings, or payment of past debts.
 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
