- 2 SECTION 5. Section 21.1095, Labor Code, as added by this
- 3 Act, applies only to an unlawful employment practice that occurs on

- 6 this Act, applies only to a discriminatory housing practice that
- 7 occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
