- (b) Any student dress or grooming policy adopted by a school 10
- district, including a student dress or grooming policy for any 11
- extracurricular activity, may not discriminate against a hair 12
- texture or protective hairstyle commonly or historically 13

- SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, 15
- 16 amended by adding Section 51.979 to read as follows:

- STUDENT DRESS OR GROOMING POLICY. (a) In this section: 18
- (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning 19
- assigned by Section 61.003. 20
- 21 (2) "Protective hairstyle" includes braids, locks,

- 23 (b) Any student dress or grooming policy adopted by an
- institution of higher education, including a student dress or 24

- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 21, Labor Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 21.1095 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 21.1095. RACIAL DISCRIMINATION BASED ON HAIR TEXTURE
- 7 OR PROTECTIVE HAIRSTYLE. (a) In this section, "protective
- 8 hairstyle" includes braids, locks, and twists.
- 9 (b) A provision in this chapter referring to discrimination
- 10 because of race or on the basis of race includes discrimination
- 11 because of or on the basis of an employee's hair texture or
- 12 protective hairstyle commonly or historically associated with
- 13 race.
- 14 (c) An employer, labor union, or employment agency commits
- 15 an unlawful employment practice if the employer, labor union, or
- 16 employment agency adopts or enforces a dress or grooming policy
- 17 that discriminates against a hair texture or protective hairstyle
- 18 commonly or historically associated with race.
- 19 SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 301, Property Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 301.0045 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 301.0045. RACIAL DISCRIMINATION BASED ON HAIR TEXTURE
- 22 OR PROTECTIVE HAIRSTYLE. (a) In this section, "protective
- 23 hairstyle" includes braids, locks, and twists.
- (b) A provision in this chapter, other than a provision in
- 25 Subchapter I, referring to discrimination because of race or on the
- 26 basis of race includes discrimination because of or on the basis of
- 27 a person's hair texture or protective hairstyle commonly or

- 2 SECTION 5. Section 21.1095, Labor Code, as added by this
- 3 Act, applies only to an unlawful employment practice that occurs on
- 4 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. Section 301.0045, Property Code, as added by
- 6 this Act, applies only to a discriminatory housing practice that
- 7 occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
