(a) The department shall issue specialty license plates to 8 9 honor law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty. The license plates must include: 10 11 (1) the words "A Hero Remembered Never Dies"; 12 (2) the words "Honoring Law Enforcement"; and 13 (3) a depiction of a badge covered by a black mourning 14 band. (b) After deduction of the department's administrative 15 16 costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates shall be deposited to the credit of an account created by the 17 comptroller in the manner provided by Section 504.6012(b). Money 18 deposited to that account may be used only by the Employees 19 Retirement System of Texas to provide financial assistance to 20 surviving family members of peace officers killed in the line of 21 duty under Chapter 615, Government Code. 22 23 (c) Section 504.702 does not apply to a specialty license plate issued under this section. 24
