| 7 | Sec. 504.680. FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER LICENSE |
| 8 | PLATES. (a) The department shall issue specialty license plates to |
| 9 | honor law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty. The |
| 10 | license plates must include: |
| 11 | (1) the words "A Hero Remembered Never Dies"; |
| 12 | (2) the words "Honoring Law Enforcement"; and |
| 13 | (3) a depiction of a badge covered by a black mourning |
| 14 | band. |
| 15 | (b) After deduction of the department's administrative |
| 16 | costs, the remainder of the fee for issuance of the license plates |
| 17 | shall be deposited to the credit of an account created by the |
| 18 | comptroller in the manner provided by Section 504.6012(b). Money |
| 19 | deposited to that account may be used only by the Employees |
| 20 | Retirement System of Texas to provide financial assistance to |
| 21 | survivors of peace officers under Chapter 615, Government Code. |
| 22 | (c) Section 504.702 does not apply to a specialty license |
| 23 | plate issued under this section. |
| 24 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. |
